TMLP Offers a New ‘Go Green 100%’ Electricity Program

(Taunton - April 24, 2019)

TMLP is proud to offer customer choice for energy through renewable options. Our new ‘Go Green 100%’ program was designed specifically for our customers who want their electricity to come from 100% renewable energy sources.

Once a customer signs up for this voluntary program, TMLP will purchase the qualifying Massachusetts Class 1 Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) to meet this customer’s electricity needs. The renewable energy source for this new voluntary electricity program will be guaranteed through the purchase of these Mass Class 1 RECs. With these RECs our customer will have our commitment that their electricity comes from renewable energy sources.

This completely voluntary program is available to all residential and commercial customers. Qualifications to participate are that you need to be the TMLP customer of record and have a \$0 balance on your account for the past 6 months. The new line item will be added our customer’s monthly invoice and will equal \$.019 per kWh for 2019. The REC market will dictate this amount in future REC purchases.

“TMLP has been investing in renewable energy initiatives since the mid 1990’s. As a public power provider, offering our customers opportunities to voluntarily participate in programs that are important to them is important to us. It is our mission to provide our rate-payers with reliable, sustainable, and cost-effective services that meet their needs.
