TMLP Launches TMLP Saves™ Heat & Pump Low-to-No Interest Loan Program

(Taunton, MA) – On Monday, September 16, 2024 TMLP’s Commission voted to launch a new version of TMLP Saves™ beginning on January 1, 2025. Since the initial \$1 million received from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) has been exhausted, TMLP recognizes there is a need for this type of program for our customers. The program offers rebates to eligible residential customers for weatherization (if recommended) and installation of Cold Climate Air Source Heat Pumps (ccASHP) or Ground Source Heat Pumps.

This new version of TMLP Saves™ is a self-sustainable program that includes pre-approved weatherization and panel upgrades as part of the low-to-no interest loan program.

“Not only will the enhanced program reduce the carbon footprint in the service territory, TMLP Saves™ Heat Pump and Low-to-No Interest will allow TMLP to offer incentives to residential customers who want to make energy saving improvements,” General Manager Kim Holmes said. “This program also provides qualified customers with options that can help with financing.”
